# Key Messages

- MMPs play a key role in the development and progression of chronic wounds
- Reducing MMP activity in stalled, chronic wounds can reduce tissue degradation and facilitate healing
- There is an increasing interest in MMP Inhibition as an “active” treatment for chronic wounds
- Benefits claimed by new technologies must be supported by strong pre-clinical and clinical evidence
